All of us can be proud that we continue to fulfill our mission "...to improve the lives of vulenerable children, adults, and families in need and people with developmental disabilities."



# Children, Youth, and Family Services

## **Children and Families in Foster Care**

Abbott House provides social support services as well as medical and mental health care for abused, neglected, and emotionally disturbed children and teenagers, and their families.

Through the Community-Based Foster Boarding Homes Program, children are matched every day with a caring foster family. If a child has special needs, he or she can find a foster family through the Therapeutic Foster Boarding Homes Program.

Bridges to Health (B2H) is a hands-on, supportive program, which launched in 2008 for children in foster care with complex medical, developmental, or mental health conditions. We offer in-home, supportive services tailored to the child's health needs and coordinated by our Health Care Integrators. Abbott House is the only social service agency that provides these services to both New York City and the Lower Hudson Valley region.



## **Prevention Services**

Abbott House works with up to 50 at-risk families in Newburgh and Poughkeepsie through the Family Assessment and Community Enhancement (FACE) Program to provide crucial early intervention services, helping children avoid the foster care system.



#### Youth Offenders

Funded by the Office of Mental Health, Abbott House's Pleasantville Community Residence provides care for emotionally disturbed adolescents. Additionally, our Non-Secure Detention program provides temporary residential care for youth accused of committing delinquent or criminal acts.


By providing youths with new skills and opportunities, Abbott House aims to make sure their first contact with the justice system will all be their last.

# **Children Awaiting Family Reunification**

The Transitional Resources for Children (TRC) Program serves up to 51 young people at any given time. These children have entered the United States from other countries without an adult guardian, and Abbott House provides short-term care and treatment while a family member or sponsor is identified. The TRC Program opened on June 3rd, 2014 thanks to a grant from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' Office.

During their stay, children receive room and board, case management, individual counseling, medical and educational services, recreation/leisure activities, acculturation, legal services, and access to religious services.

# Services for the Developmentally Disabled

Abbott House has 17 residential programs located throughout Westchester, Rockland, and the Bronx for people who are intellectually or developmentally disabled.

Our Day Habilitation Programs focus on teaching every individual to be a meaningful member of their community, and groups often volunteer at local fire department, animal shelters, and deliver Meals on Wheels.

# Additional Support Services:

#### Medicaid Service Coordination

Medicaid Service Coordinators serve as advocates for individuals with disabilities in a one-on-one basis to ensure their needs are met.

#### Self-Advocacy

Self-Advocacy is a program that teaches individuals leadership skills while empowering them to speak about issues they find important.

#### **Residential Services**

Behavior specialists consult with individuals to create goals that are important to the individual and plans that fit within that person's capability to achieve them.
